

Attaching heparin syringe to heparin administration line

Before attaching the syringe to the heparin administration line, insure that both the syringe and administration line are completely free of air.

Rationale:

Even the smallest amount of air can allow the migration of blood into the syringe.






Attaching heparin syringe to heparin administration line

Aseptically attach the syringe to the Heparin administration line.







Release the unlocking lever by pushing tab up on the right.

Slide the clip to the right to open and place syringe.





Pull and turn syringe bracket down.

Insert syringe in such a way that the syringe wings are securely placed in the syringe gripping plate.


Turn syringe bracket up to hold syringe in place.



Slide clip toward syringe until aligned with syringe hub.

Pull syringe hub slightly forward with index finger, placing syringe hub in the clip.


Do not manually close the unlocking lever.





Push on syringe wings until unlocking lever automatically locks syringe into place.

If there is no sound (snap) when the lock engages, the syringe may not be properly loaded.





Unclamp heparin infusion clamp as per policy and procedure.

Set heparin parameters according to the patient prescription.
